Founded in September 2003, Eve Center provides a free, faith-based, safe place for support women age 15 and above to be heard, to heal and to grow. Headquarters is located in Silverton/Kenwood with a satellite office in Price Hill. The Eve Center draws volunteers and clients who are geographically, socio-economically, racially, and denominationally diverse. Through one-to-one sessions, group support and self help, women move through pain and crisis to hope and recovery.
