

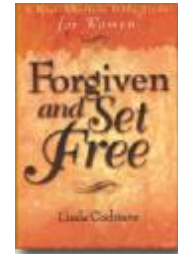


## FALL 2009 BOOK STUDIES AND GROUPS

### **#2: DIVORCECARE – A seminar with a experts on video and a support group with FOCUS: [www.DivorceCare.org](http://www.DivorceCare.org)**

Most people will tell you that separation and divorce are the most painful and stressful experiences they've ever faced. It's a confusing time when you feel isolated and have lots of questions about issues you've never faced before. After viewing each video, DivorceCare group participants spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in the lives of group members. Topics include: What's Happening to Me?, Facing My Anger, Facing My Depression, Facing My Loneliness, Financial Survival, Moving On, Growing Closer to God. 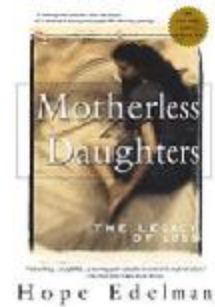

**#4: MOTHERLESS DAUGHTERS** – book by Hope Edelman, workbook by Mary Ellen Collins

Ask any woman who has experienced mother loss through death, physical absence, or emotional absence and she will tell you that she is irrevocably altered and profoundly changed. The book is based on hundreds of interviews with women who lost their mothers from childhood through adult years. We will utilize Scripture and an accompanying workbook to enhance the learning experience. The study searches for understanding of:

- How the absence of a mother's nurturing hand shapes a woman's identity
- How present-day relationships are shaped by past losses
- How mother-loss influences our style of mothering
- How the grief of mother-loss surfaces throughout our lifetime
- How we experience living beyond our mother's final years

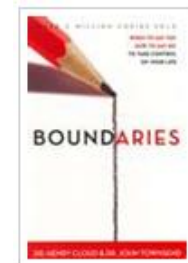
