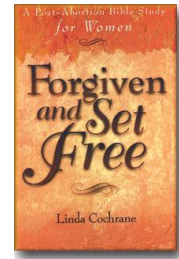
#1: FORGIVEN & SET FREE – Bible Study by Linda Cochrane

#2: ARMS – Abuse Recovery Ministry and Services, Inc., book Her Journey by Stacey Womack

Her Journey classes help women walk through their healing process from all types of domestic abuse. Women who are struggling - or have struggled - with any type of domestic abuse, including emotional, verbal, sexual, spiritual, financial, animal, property and/or physical abuse are welcome to attend.

Women are welcome to join at anytime. Her Journey is based on Psalm 23: God is with them during this "valley of the shadow of death" time in their lives, He knows their hearts and prepares "green pastures and still waters" where they can release their anger, be refreshed, and follow God's lead. The curriculum assures women of God's love for them because we are, each one of us, precious and wondrously made.

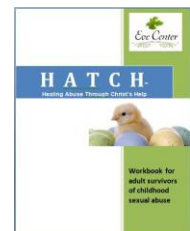
#3: HATCH – Healing Abuse Through Christ Help – Topical Study copyright Eve Center

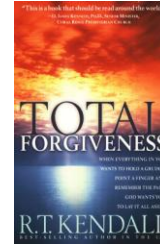
